

## Swansea Historical Society Photo Gallery

### 1. Mr. Ellis' Cows

Looking east from Ellis Avenue to Grenadier Pond in 1891, the cattle of John Ellis Jr. are being milked in the pasture.

### 2. Ellis Ave

This photograph, taken by John Ellis Jr., is looking north up Ellis Avenue from the front of the Muir property showing the corner of number 203 . It was taken before the street was re-graded. The house on the left now sits well below the street grade. Date unknown.

### 3. 1900 Swansea

This view is looking south from Morningside, east of Ellis Avenue, with Grenadier Pond on the left. The sandbar between the Pond and Lake Ontario can be seen at the south end of the Pond. Date unknown.

### 4. Kennedy Avenue Cyclists

Cyclists on Kennedy Ave near Runnymede go past the windmill. Circa 1905.

### 5. The Minnies

The "Minnies" were the mineral baths, originally part of the facilities of the Strathcona Hospital (seen on the hill at the top right of the picture). Later it was one of the most popular swimming facilities in western Toronto. It disappeared with the building of the Bloor Subway. The hospital treated TB patient and later became a maternity hospital.
